EXPANSION OF SPECIALIST PROVISION AT BURTON END

We recently held a consultation to explore extending our Specialist Provision (Hub) to cater for 24 children and increase the age range to incorporate Key Stage 2 children. We are pleased to tell you our capital building project will allow for this to happen.

Our Nursery will be relocating to our new build classroom at the top of our Car Park (where the building works have started) and Miss Butt is very much looking forward to shaping this new space.

Our existing Nursery and Wraparound Care Classrooms at the front of school will become our SEND Hub catering for our two linked classrooms 'Explorers' and 'Adventurers' and a new outdoor area. Our popular Wraparound Care provision will move to our existing Explorers classroom. We will shortly be sending more information about Breakfast and After School Club.

YOU ARE ARE WELCOME TO JOIN US ON THE FIELD FOR A PICNIC LUNCH WITH YOUR CHILDREN FROM 12.15PM. BEFORE SPORTS DAYS START WE WILL TAKE CHILDREN BACK INTO SCHOOL FOR REGISTRATION.

- There is very little shade on the field please ensure you child has a hat, water bottle and that you apply sun cream you could do this again at lunch time if you wish.
- We will put out as may chairs as we can for spectators. Feel free to bring camping type chairs to guarantee you have a seat.
- · Children are encouraged to wear their house colours.
- For safety reasons please ensure the track is kept clear at all times and that you remain in the area allocated for parents.
- Remember: the school and its grounds are 'no smoking/vaping areas'
- · Please do not bring dogs, alcohol or glass bottles onto the premises.
- We understand many of you will want to photograph your children during Sports Day. Any photographs taken must be for private mementos and must not be shared publicly or through social media.
- In the interests of safety and to aid supervision, we ask that no adult approaches the children during sporting events but please feel free to wave across the track (and cheer as loudly as you can!)
- Please do not leave litter on the school field as this is a health and safety hazard. We have a limited number of bins so would appreciate it if you could take rubbish home with you to dispose of.
- Children will return to their classrooms at the end of Sports Day and be dismissed as normal.
